



**Global Impact Scholarship Application 2020:**  
*Deadline April 1, 2020*

Scholarships typically range from \$250-\$1,500. Scholarships are applied directly toward your program fee and will not be applied to application fees/deposits. In selecting recipients, the Committee considers the academic, personal, and, in some cases, technical qualifications of each applicant. Please note that funds are limited and we are unable to award a scholarship to every applicant.

If you cancel your participation in the Global Impact program or the program is canceled for some reason, you will not receive your scholarship amount in a refund.

**Eligibility:** In order to be eligible for a scholarship from the Seattle Colleges, you must be registered in courses Winter, Spring, or Summer in the same year before the Global Impact program or pre-registered for Fall right after the Global Impact trip. Please follow the guidelines below.

**SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS**

In order to be considered for a scholarship from the Seattle Colleges, you must

1. Complete Application Cover Sheet (following page)
2. Answer both essay questions provided below
3. Submit your latest transcript (unofficial is fine).
4. Submit one scholarship recommendation from a faculty member, advisor, employer, or volunteer supervisor who has worked with you during the past two years.
5. If you are a financial aid recipient, please provide a copy of your award letter or proof of your financial aid eligibility.
6. Complete and submit this scholarship application with all parts by **April 1 deadline**. Applications must be emailed or postmarked by April 1. Awards will be announced within 15 days of deadline.

**Essay Responses: Please answer both questions in a separate (word processed) document and limit your answers to 200 words per question. Please include your name, email address, and which college you are attending on the essay paper.**

1) Please describe how you expect the projects and location of this program to contribute to the achievement of your academic, career, and personal goals.

2) Please describe a cross-cultural experience you have had and the insight you gained from it.
